

# Step Out at SWFC

## The Wednesday Walk on Thursdays



64 – Malin Bridge – 2.6 miles

Looking at the routes round the Stadium, there are a few that get vey muddy, and in view of the weather recently I have found one which is mainly road walking. This one also covers the next part of the river Loxley below it's confluence with the Rivelin, which fits in with the other river walks we have done recently.

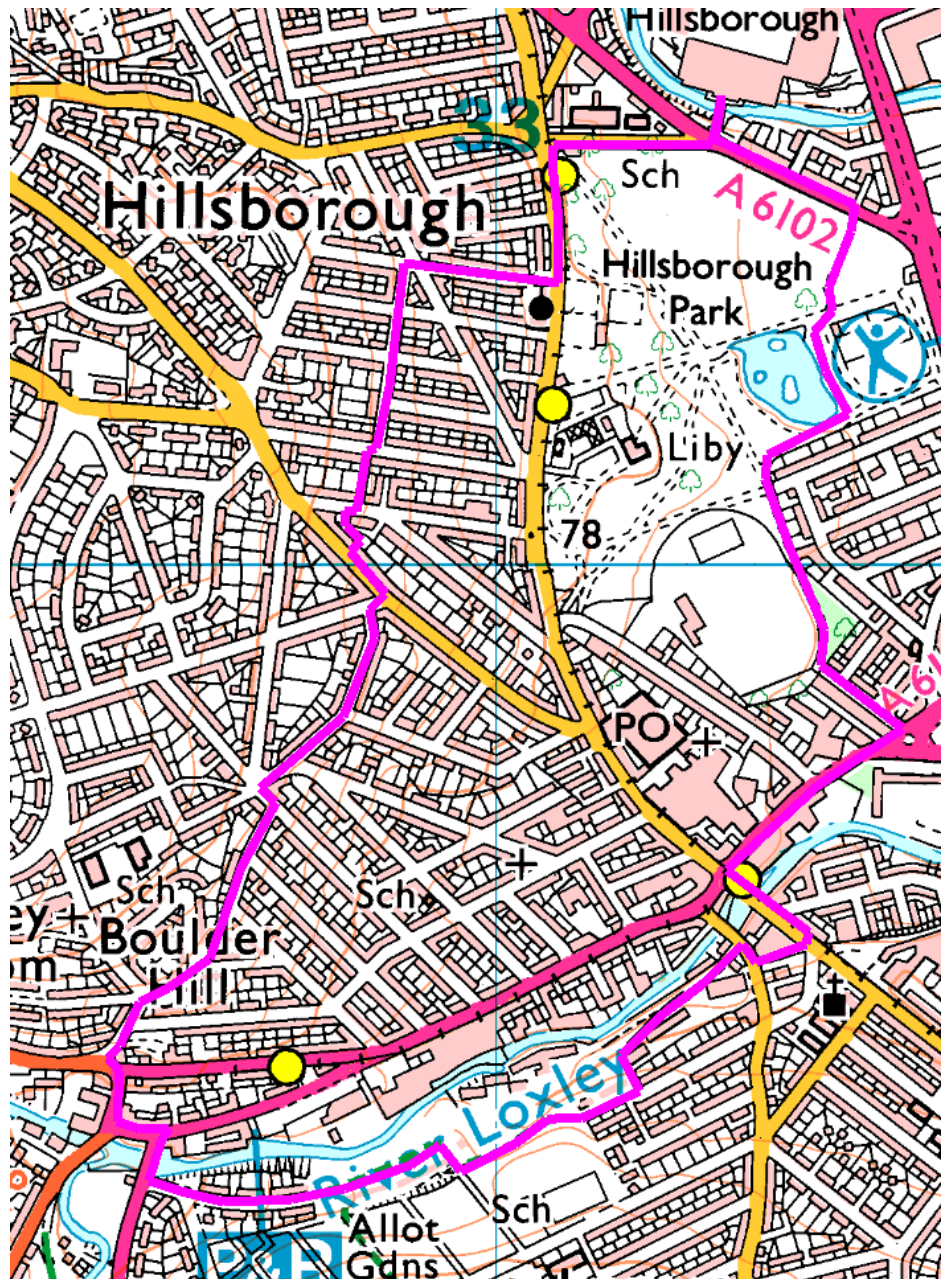
Anticlockwise

This route takes us by the shortest route to Malin Bridge, which involves a bit of uphill, but the up is all in the first half of the walk.

Over the bridge, cross the road and turn right beside the park up Parkside Road. Follow the pavement round onto Middlewood Road and cross at the crossing before coming back to Lennox Road. Cross Dixon Road and turn left into Upwood Road.

At the end of Upwood Road, cross Wynyard Road and take the jinnel through to Leader Road. Cross over and through Leader Court and Dykes Hall Gardens out onto Dykes Hall Road. Turn left then right and left onto Portsea Road. At Oakland Road turn left then right onto Rippon Road and follow round to Dykes Lane. Drop down and over the Rivelin bridge then turn left into Watersmeet Road.

At the end of Watersmeet Road, follow the path round to Thoresby Road, then down the jinnel (after number 68) into Limbrick Road. At Walkley Lane turn right and take the path beside Wetherspoons to cross Langsett Road at the crossing. Turn left, cross the bridge and turn right into Bradfield Road. Cross at the crossing and then at the roundabout, turn left into Hawksley Road and back through the park.



Risks:

- A few busy roads to cross and some quieter roads to follow – please be careful.
- Park and footpath, watch out for dogs, cyclists and joggers.
