

Step Out at SWFC

The Wednesday Walk on Thursdays



Walk 110 – Morrisons – 2.4 miles (but quite hilly)

This short mile walk is quite hilly, (it is around Hillsborough, after all) but there are no stiles, no steps and no mud! There is a bit of grass to walk on (the tarmac path is a bit longer), but it's mainly hard paths so trainers / soft shoes / sandals are recommended. Park in Morrisons car park (upper level) and head to Morrisons café for tea / coffee afterwards.

Clockwise:

Leave the car park onto Langsett Road and turn left then right up Burnaby Street. At the top, turn left and cross the grass to Langsett Crescent. At the junction with Freedom Court go straight on along the jinnel between the houses to come out on 'Green Square'. Here you have a choice, either follow the tarmac round 2 sides of the square, or cut straight across the middle.

On the other side of the grass, join the path and go straight on out to pass the Wycliffe Congregational Church. Here you can turn left down the slope then right between the houses, or go straight on down Grammar Street. When you reach Whitehouse Lane, follow it down till it changes to Fox Road, then after a few yards take the path on the left through Philadelphia Gardens. Keep bearing left till you come out on the road (confusingly called Philadelphia Gardens as well),

turn right and at the top go straight on through the jinnel to Portland Street. Go on to Daniel Hill and turn right, past Zest to enter Uppertorpe Peace Garden on the left. Head diagonally across to exit onto Brandreth Close then turn right onto Brandreth Road and enter Blake Street Nature Park. Once on Blake Street, turn right and cross Daniel Hill Street to enter Ruskin Park. Past the zip wire, turn right then left to leave the park on Burgoyne Road. Turn right then left on Whitehouse Road, straight on on Whitehouse Road and on to Walkley Road. As you pass the end of Burnaby Crescent, you have a choice. Turn right here, then left **down** Burnaby Walk to return to the cars via Burnaby Street, or go on **up** Walkley Road, out onto Walkley Lane and down the steps to Hammerton Road to get back to the car park.

Risks:

Road walking, so cars, kerbs and dog muck! Hopefully no mud, ice or other slippery stuff.
