## Walk and Talk The 'Wednesday' Walk on Thursdays



## 192 - Bud Lane from More Hall - 2.4 miles

This walk is half of walk 58, which we did back in July 2022 (and which was a bit challenging). It's not a long walk but it's up and down with only a little bit of level at the start and end. Mainly good underfoot, so rated at 2 – not much mud but some (possibly wet) grass, so bring your sticks.

Park by the dam at More Hall.

## Counterclockwise

Cross the dam and follow beside the waters edge for 400 metres (you can walk along the beach if the tide is out) then turn left up through the trees. Where the track turns right take the footpath straight on, across a field and up to Carr House Lane.

Turn left then right over a ladder stile, then follow the path diagonally across the field to a gate in the hedge, straight across the next field to another gate, then head towards the ladder stile out into Bud Lane. Turn right and follow the track uphill, bearing left and coming out past Eaton House Farm, out to the road. Turn left and follow Brightholmlee Road all the way down to the T junction, turning right into Brightholmlee itself.

After the dilapidated support for the dilapidated barn turn left on the footpath between the buildings. Follow the path across a field and through the woods down to the reservoir and then sharp turn

right back to the dam (there is a shortcut with a bit of a scramble down, if you fancy it) and back to the cars.

## Risks

A bit of road walking on narrow roads so watch (and listen) for cars, bikes, etc. A few stiles (with steps)
Footpaths (mud, slipping, tree roots, steps, etc).
Some walking across grass which may be slippery.
